Course background and aims:



After launching of the World Port Sustainability Program (WPSP) on 23 March 2018, it became crucial for ports and port community to focus on the sustainable development of its operations and services and find ways of managing their ports efficiently and effectively while being consistent with the 17 UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) announced in 25 September 2015.

This is a multi-disciplinary course delivered by a variety of senior experts in all sustainability-related fields, as Sustainable Development (SD) is inherently a multi-faceted approach because it concerns a complex system involving economy, technology, ecology, supply chains, logistics and others, which makes the course extremely important for all seaport personnel at all levels including port authorities, shipping companies and agencies, multimodal operation staff, and local communities.

The course provides the necessary knowledge for implementing Sustainable Development in the areas of future-proof infrastructure; climate and energy; social integration; safety and security; and ethical policy, while tackling the pressing environmental issues in moving to the development of green ports and a low carbon economy, and discussing their effects on port development and operations, which will enhance their competitiveness and help them hold a prominent place in future markets and investments.

Course scope:



This is a two weeks course; the first week will take place in Port Training Institute (PTI) Alexandria, Egypt, while the second one will be in Antwerp/Flanders Port Training Center (APEC) Antwerp, Belgium. Upon completion of this course, participants will gain a deep understanding of the practical implementation of the sustainable development of ports in accordance with World Port Sustainability Program themes in all port operations and activities.


